

INVITATION TO BID – EXTENSION OF BID DEADLINE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT sealed bids will be received by the City of Fellsmere until **2:00 P.M. on September 29, 2017**, at which time the bids will be opened, for furnishing all labor and materials for the following project:

Reconstruction of two Historic Fellsmere Railroad Structures (machine shop and blacksmith shop) consisting of providing materials, machinery, equipment, labor utilities and permits to construct two wood frame structures, approximately 1,705 square feet and 225 square feet respectively, including but not limited to: slab foundations, framing, windows, doors, roofing, flooring, interior finishes, HVAC, electric, plumbing, site electric and water service, and ancillaries needed to complete the specified construction as more specifically in the Bid Documents.

Bids may be sent by mail or hand-delivered to 22 South Orange Street, Fellsmere, Florida 32948. Bids will be publicly opened at 2:00 p.m. and read aloud in the City Council Chambers, 21 S. Cypress Street, Fellsmere, FL 32948.

Bids received after the time set for the opening of the bids will not be considered and will be returned unopened, subject to the provisions of the Instructions to Bidders.

Copies of the general conditions, plans and specifications and other bidding documents are on file at the Community Development Department, 22 S. Orange Street, Fellsmere, FL 32948, and open for public inspection. Complete sets of general conditions, plans and specifications and other bidding documents may be obtained by applying to Mark D. Mathes, Community Development Department, 22 S. Orange Street, Fellsmere, FL 32948, at a cost of \$50.00 per set.

All bids shall be submitted on the Bid Proposal forms provided in the Specifications. Bid security will be required in the amount of five percent (5%) of the bid and must accompany the sealed proposal of each bidder as follows: a cashier's check, a certified check or a surety bond payable to the City of Fellsmere. Deposits will be returned to unsuccessful bidders. If the Contract is awarded to a Bidder, that Bidder shall enter into a Contract with the City and furnish the required Performance and Payment Bonds and Certificates of Insurance or forfeit the Bid Bond or security as liquidated damages. A contract must be executed within ten (10) days following the award of the successful bidder.

The City reserves the right to delay the awarding of the Contract for up to sixty (60) days after the bid opening, to waive informalities in any bid, or to reject any or all bids in whole or in part with or without cause/or to accept the bid that, in its judgment, will serve the best interests of the City.
