

**RESOLUTION
NO. 2010-29**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF FELLSMERE, INDIAN RIVER COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING RESOLUTION 2009-W APPENDIX "A", SECTION 1, MONTHLY WATER RATE INSIDE CITY; AMENDING SECTION 2, MONTHLY WATER RATE OUTSIDE CITY; AMENDING SECTION 3, APPENDIX "B" MONTHLY WASTEWATER RATES; PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY OF ORDINANCE 2000-01, ARTICLE IV WATER AND WASTEWATER SERVICE; FURTHER PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2000-01, in Chapter 78, Article IV Water and Wastewater Service, Code of Ordinances, City of Fellsmere, Florida, provides that all rates, fees and charges associated with the public water and wastewater systems shall be established by separate Resolution; and

WHEREAS, it is the purpose of this Resolution to amend certain fees and charges associated with the public water and wastewater systems, as established in Resolution 2009-W, Appendix "A", and Appendix "B"

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Fellsmere, Florida, as follows:

SECTION 1. MONTHLY WATER RATE INSIDE CITY.

The monthly water rate for service rendered inside the corporate limits shall be as stated in "Appendix A" and made a part thereof.

SECTION 2. MONTHLY WATER RATE OUTSIDE CITY.

The monthly water rate for service rendered outside the corporate limits shall be as stated in Appendix "A" and made a part hereof.

SECTION 3. MONTHLY WASTEWATER RATES.

The monthly wastewater rates shall be as stated in "Appendix B" as attached hereto and made a part thereof.

SECTION 3. REPEALING OF CONFLICTING PROVISIONS.

All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution shall take effect the 1st day of October 2010.
