

## NOTICE UNDER THE AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT

The Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (ADA) forbid discrimination against those with disabilities. In accordance with the ADA, the City of Fellsmere will not discriminate against qualified individuals with disabilities on the basis of disability in its services, programs, or activities.

The City of Fellsmere will generally, upon request, provide appropriate aids and services leading to effective communication for persons with disabilities and to provide special assistance to access facilities, programs, services, or activities, so they can participate equally in the City of Fellsmere's services, programs, and activities. Because providing reasonable accommodations may require outside assistance, organization or resources, the City requests that requests be made at least one (1) week before the scheduled event.
