A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF FELLSMERE, INDIAN RIVER COUNTY, FLORIDA ADOPTING APPLICATION PERMIT FEE FOR RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL ALARM SITES, APPENDIX "A"; ADOPTING A FEE SCHEDULE FOR PERMITTED COMMERCIAL AND RESIDENTIAL ALARM SITES FOR FALSE ALARMS AND A FEE SCHEDULE FOR NON-PERMITTED COMMERCIAL AND RESIDENTIAL FALSE ALARM CHARGES, APPENDIX "B" PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY OF ORDINANCE 05-02, REGULATION OF ALARMS; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Ordinance 05-02, Regulation of Alarms, provides for permitting of alarms and charges associated with false alarms; and

WHEREAS, The purpose of this Resolution is to adopt certain fees and charges associated with registering alarm systems and false alarms.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Fellsmere, Indian River County, Florida, as follows:

**SECTION 1. APPLICATION PERMIT FEE FOR RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL ALARM SITES.**

1. The annual application permit fee for residential and commercial alarm sites shall be as stated in "Appendix "A" and made a part thereof.

**SECTION 2. FEE SCHEDULE FOR PERMITTED AND NON-PERMITTED COMMERCIAL AND RESIDENTIAL FALSE ALARM CHARGES.**

1. The fines associated with permitted and non-permitted false alarm charges for residential and commercial alarm sites shall be as stated in "Appendix "B" and made a part thereof.

**SECTION 3. CONFLICTS.**

All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

This Resolution shall take effect on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2005.

**APPENDIX "B" – RESOLUTION 05-F**

**SECTION 1. Fee schedule for permitted commercial and residential false alarm charges.**

First false alarm	No Charge
Second false alarm	No Charge
Third false alarm	\$ 25.00
Fourth false alarm	\$ 50.00
Fifth false alarm	\$ 75.00

For each false alarm exceeding the fifth shall be assessed an additional \$25.00 fee.

**SECTION 2. Fee schedule for non-permitted commercial or residential false alarm charges.**

1. The first dispatch, the alarm administrator shall waive this additional fine for a non-permitted system, if the alarm user applies for a permit within 10 calendar days after such violation. Any subsequent false alarm dispatches will continue to be fined as referenced above.
